INTRODUCTION

This volume reports on the fourth round of elections for Regional and Islands Area Councils held since the reorganisation of Scottish local government in 1974.

We have resisted the temptation to change the format because we believe that continuity of presentation has many advantages. Furthermore, adequate data are given to enable readers to pursue their own analyses. These elections were held, in the main, on the same boundaries as those of 1982, but two Regions had additional electoral divisions. In Fife, electoral division 14 was divided into two - ED14 and ED46; and Grampian acquired three new divisions - ED21 was divided into ED21 and ED21A; ED24 was divided into ED24 and ED24A; and ED49 was divided into ED49 and ED49A. These new EDs are indicated by an * after the ED number. Other Regions had minor boundary changes which had no significant electoral implications. Our table of gains and losses excludes the new divisions.

As usual the volume is organised in four sections, the introduction, a commentary on the results and analysis of trends, the detailed results for each Region and summary tables. We have also included, this year, appendices which give a list of seats changing hands and revised and corrected details of the composition of various electoral units.

Women candidates are identified with the prefix Ms and the following symbols are used.

=Retiring councillor elected in 1982

*Retiring councillor elected at a by-election since May 1982

+Retiring councillor who has changed parties since May 1982

-Retiring councillor standing in another or new division.

Where a gain or loss is indicated this is in relation to the 1982 result and disregards by-election changes.

COMMENTARY ON THE RESULTS

In previous commentaries on Scottish local election results we have attempted to combine an analysis of trends over time and a detailed consideration of the election in question. On this occasion, however, we have more clearly separated these two aspects of our analysis dealing firstly with the development of party competition in Scotland as a whole and then going on to consider Regional variations and other topics with reference to the 1986 elections.

Party Competition in Regional Elections

There can be little doubt that the most significant development in Scottish Regional elections since the formation of the Regional Councils in 1974 has been the steady incursion of political parties into electoral competition. By 1982 all four major political parties (Conservative, Labour, Alliance and SNP) were heavily involved in Regional elections. In the six "partisan" Regions (Grampian, Tayside, Fife, Lothian, Central, Strathclyde) containing about 90.0 percent of the electorate, party competition was overwhelmingly the norm. In Scotland as a whole too, the proportion of Independent candidates had more than halved. In our commentary on the 1982 results we suggested that a four-party system could be developing at Regional level. The results of the 1983 General Election suggested that this possibility remained open since Scotland returned MPs of all four parties to Westminster and in respect of candidacies and contests the 1986 Regional elections provide further evidence to support this view.

Candidates and Contests

Table A shows the number of candidates each party put forward in 1986 compared with 1982. In the partisan Regions increases in the number of Labour (+3), Alliance (+14) and SNP candidates (+62) more than offset the small decline (-16) in the number of Conservative candidates. In these Regions the SNP contested 92.0 percent of divisions, Labour 89.0 percent, the Conservatives 73.0 percent and the Alliance 69.0 percent.

While the Alliance and the Conservatives have room for advances, Labour and the SNP are close to saturation point in terms of candidacies in partisan Regions. The record number of candidates in 1986 was partly a product of the presence of a large number of Green Party representatives (69), but it is difficult to know whether this represents the first appearance of a new political force or merely a temporary flurry of ecological interest which will not be repeated. The higher level of party participation has important consequences for the nature of the choices facing electors. Table B shows the incidence of various forms of electoral competition in 1982 and 1986 again distinguishing partisan and non-partisan Regions.

In partisan Regions, the proportion of divisions that witnessed a contest between at least two major-party candidates rose from 92.0 percent to 96.0 percent between 1982 and 1986. Put another way, only 14 of 335 divisions in these Regions did not have such a contest in 1986. In contrast, in non-partisan Regions the percentage of major-party contests declined and a pattern of unopposed returns of Independents remained common.

The trend in unopposed returns since 1974 is shown in Table C. It is clear that as party competition has increased in the partisan Regions, the incidence of unopposed returns has steadily diminished. In contrast, following the first flurry of activity in 1974, unopposed returns in non-partisan Regions seem to have stabilised at around two-fifths of divisions. Those who deplore "politics" in local government should recognise that at least "politics" promotes electoral competition. A somewhat similar point can be made with reference to turnout in contested divisions. Table D shows the trend in this case.

In every round of Regional elections the turnout of voters has been greater in the partisan Regions and the gap between these and the non-partisan Regions has been widening. In 1986 areas of party competition had a turnout almost five points higher than the others despite the fact that Grampian, a partisan Region, had the lowest turnout of any individual Region (as it has had in all four sets of elections). A small proportion of uncontested seats and higher turnouts are by-products of party competition. Our final piece of evidence about the changing nature of party competition in Scotland is given in Table E. Thus far we have referred only to "party contests" defining these as any contest involving two or more candidates of the major parties. Such contests can take many forms however and the table shows how these have changed since 1974.

In 1974 straight fights between Labour and the Conservatives were the commonest form of party contest, accounting for two-fifths of such contests, while other straight fights accounted for another fifth. Only five percent of party contests involved all four parties. Four years later the situation changed markedly. The number of SNP candidates rose sharply and as a result there were many more triangular contests. More than half of contests were of the Conservative v Labour v SNP variety. Four-way contests remained rare, however. In 1982, following the formation of the SDP and its alliance with the Liberals there was another sea change. Four-way contests were now the commonest (45.0 percent of contests) and there were corresponding declines in three-way and two-way battles. This trend continued in 1986. More than half of the contests involved all four parties. The only form of straight fight to have occurred in significant numbers was Labour v SNP and these contests were concentrated in just two Regions (Central and Fife). Not a single division in the partisan Regions had a straight fight between Labour and Conservative - a clear indication of the change in the form of party competition at Regional elections since 1974. If, then, party systems could be adequately characterised on the basis of candidatures there would be good grounds for arguing that the 1986 Regional elections saw a continuation of the trend towards competitive four-party politics in Scotland. But, of course, candidatures tell only one side of the story and when we consider the outcome of the elections a rather different picture emerges.

Patterns of Party Support

The most significant influence on the results of the 1982 Regional elections was the intervention of the Alliance for the first time on a large scale. In addition, the Labour Party nationally was in disarray and was tumbling in the polls as the Conservatives benefitted from the government's handling of the Falklands crisis. Despite these portents, Labour held its own in the elections and it was the Conservatives and the SNP who suffered losses, though the Conservative losses may have been dampened by the Falklands war and the "Lothian" affair.

In the run up to the 1986 elections things looked different. Labour under its new "realistic" leadership seemed to be back on the rails and the party was benefitting in the polls from the more centrist image being projected. The Conservatives, in contrast were in the doldrums. The government had committed a series of gaffes beginning with the Westland affair and in Scotland in particular there was much discontent, within as well as outside the Conservative Party, over the government's handling of the teachers' dispute, rating revaluation, the closure of the Gartcosh steel plant and the question of welfare allowances during severe weather. In all of these cases the Conservatives appeared indifferent to Scottish interests.

Both the SNP and Alliance, on the other hand, had some cause for optimism. The SNP had been slowly creeping up in Scottish opinion polls and had gained a number of council seats in local by-elections. The Alliance had also performed well in local by-elections in England and were in a strong position in national opinion polls. Its strength in Scotland, however, remained more problematical.

The distribution of votes at the 1982 and 1986 elections is shown in Table F.

Clearly the Conservatives suffered a major setback. In partisan Regions their vote fell to 17.3 percent, by far their worst performance at local level in Scotland since reorganisation. They were outpolled by the SNP whose slight recovery in popular support was confirmed as they increased their vote share to 18.6 percent. The SNP also overtook the Alliance whose vote declined to 15.5 percent, although the Alliance's disappointment could be tempered by the fact that this was a slight improvement upon their performance in the 1984 District elections. It is Labour's showing which catches the eye, however. From an already predominant position Labour's vote increased

sharply. They obtained their largest level of support to date at Regional elections, far outstripping their competitors.

Due to the small numbers of votes involved, changes in patterns of support in non-partisan Regions are not very significant although it is worth noting how Independents maintained their dominance while falling further back over the country as a whole.

As we have cautioned in previous analyses of local election results, the figures in Table F are "raw", taking no account of variations in candidatures and unopposed returns. The SNP as we have seen, for example, sharply increased its number of candidates between 1982 and 1986 and that might partly explain its apparent recovery. But its average vote per candidate did increase. A check on the trends identified in Table F is made in Table G which shows the four parties' shares of the votes in divisions which all four contested in both 1982 and 1986, of which there were 108. While the precise percentages are, of course, slightly different from those given in Table F trends are similar although these data suggest an even stronger Labour advance than the "raw" figures and (not unexpectedly given their increased number of candidates) a rather more modest SNP gain.

Noting trends from one local election to the next is, of course, largely of interest to local government specialists or local politicians. Most political commentators and national politicians are more concerned about trends in relation to general elections. Table H gives an indication of these trends by comparing the 1983 General Election results in Scotland with the distribution of votes in all wards (166) having a four-party contest in the 1984 District elections and all divisions (165) having a four-party contest in the 1986 Regional elections.

Clearly the Conservatives are in steep decline in Scotland while Labour has recovered from its relatively poor performance in the 1983 general election. The SNP seems to be staging something of a come-back while the Alliance, though suffering a drop of support, are hanging on to a respectable share of the Scottish vote. It would be unwise, however, to extrapolate from these figures to make predictions about the outcome of the next general election, although the MORI poll published in the Scotsman on 5 May 1986 closely reflects the figures in the third column of Table H. The electorate is highly volatile and the next election may be still two years away. In addition, voters will be confronted with a different set of tactical situations in a general election and this is likely to affect their behaviour. It does seem clear, however that if the Conservatives do not do something to improve their electoral fortunes in Scotland they face the prospect of losing a significant number of the 21 parliamentary seats they now hold. The Conservatives do not now control a single Regional Council; they have a majority on only four of the 53 District Councils (with only 5.0 percent of the Scottish electorate) and in only one of the non-partisan Regions (Dumfries & Galloway) can they boast a member of parliament.

The impression conveyed by the voting figures of overwhelming Labour predominance in the 1986 Regional elections is emphasised when the distribution of seats won is considered. These data are shown in Table I.

In partisan Regions, the number of seats won by the Conservatives was almost halved. Labour, on the other hand, advanced to over 60.0 percent of the seats at stake. Advances were also made by the Alliance and the SNP but both still have a relatively minor presence in regional councils. Once again the number of Independent Councillors declined.

Labour now has an absolute majority of seats in four Regions (Fife, Lothian, Central and Strathclyde) which together contain some 74.0 percent of the Scottish electorate and they are the largest party in two others (Grampian and Tayside). The remaining three Regions (Highland, Borders and Dumfries & Galloway) are "controlled" by Independents. The trend towards four-party politics as indicated by contests and candidatures is, then, rather superficial. As at District level, Regional politics is best characterised as a system of one party predominance with three "also-rans".

It remains to be seen whether the other parties become disheartened by Labour's apparent impregnability or whether they will continue to plug away in the hope that something will turn up which may undermine Labour's position.

Regional Variations

In this section we consider the 1986 election results in more detail looking first at Regional variations in the results and then commenting on women candidates, minor parties and the performance of the Alliance.

(i) Candidatures

Detailed figures relating to candidates within the individual Regions are given in Summary Table 3. Compared with 1982 the most significant changes was in Grampian where there were an additional 20 Alliance and 20 SNP candidates. This Region's total of 178 candidates represents an increase of 44 over 1982. The number of candidates increased in all Regions, however, with the exception of Highland (-2) and Dumfries and Galloway (-9) in which the major parties put forward fewer candidates.

Summary Table 2 shows the proportion of divisions in each Region which was contested. In four Regions (Tayside, Lothian, Central and Strathclyde) the figure was 100.0 percent. Lothian has now had all divisions contested in three successive Regional elections and was, indeed, the only Region to reach this figure in 1982. Grampian and Fife had 93.0 percent and 97.8 percent of divisions contested respectively. Only in the non-partisan Regions were there high proportions of uncontested seats with 50.0 percent contested in Highland, 82.6 percent in Borders and 57.2 percent in Dumfries and Galloway.

(ii) Turnout

Regional turnouts are shown in Summary Table 8. Turnout increased in every Region except Borders but even the greatly increased number of candidates in Grampian did not prevent that Region from coming bottom of the "turnout league" for the fourth consecutive time. Excluding Borders the turnout increase ranged from +1.0 in Highlands to +3.7 in Fife.

(iii) Party Support

Summary Tables 9 and 10 contain data on party support in the Regions. These figures emphasise Labour's strength in the central industrial belt of Scotland and in particular in the massive Strathclyde Region where they obtained more than half of the votes. In contrast the Conservatives could muster only 13.1 percent of the Strathclyde vote and trailed in fourth place. The relatively small number of Tory candidates in Fife and Central largely accounts for their poor showing in those Regions but no such excuses can be offered for the abysmal Conservative performance in Strathclyde. The best Alliance performance was in Grampian (25.7 percent of the vote) but they clearly need to

increase their presence in Central in order to make any sort of impact and they appear to have lost out to the SNP in Tayside. The latter was probably the SNP's best performance. They achieved a higher share in Central (34.3 percent compared to 27.9 percent) but faced much less competition from other parties.

Changes in the parties' share of votes in the partisan Regions are shown in Table J. Changes in candidatures account for some of the variations found.

Thus the much more extensive Alliance and SNP challenges in Grampian clearly affected not only their own but also the other parties' votes. Similarly, the SNP had 18 extra candidates in Fife. Labour's showing in Lothian seems unusually good because they did rather badly there in 1982 because of special local factors. Broadly speaking, however, the national picture of steep Conservative decline, the Alliance falling back and Labour and the SNP increasing in popularity is confirmed in all Regions.

(iv) The Cities

As a final indicator of trends in party support we show in Table K the shares of the four-party vote in the four Scottish cities in 1986 as compared with the 1983 General Election. These are especially valuable comparisons because the great majority of divisions in the cities had candidates of all four parties and the population covered is identical in 1983 and 1986.

Labour dominance of Glasgow is complete. With almost 60.0 percent of the vote they won all but one of the Regional divisions in the city. The Conservatives, in contrast, were reduced to a poor fourth place and did not win a single seat. Labour also predominates in Aberdeen and Dundee, though not quite so spectacularly. Only

Edinburgh retains moderately close competition between the parties. The city results also confirm the national trend since the General Election with each showing increases in Labour and SNP support (except in Dundee where the SNP hold one of the parliamentary seats) and decreases in support for the Conservatives and the Alliance. On these results the division of parliamentary seats in the cities would have been 19 to Labour and 2 to the Conservatives (Edinburgh Pentlands and Edinburgh West) compared with the current situation of 14 Labour, 5 Conservative, 1 Alliance and 1 SNP.

Women Candidates

Summary Tables 6 and 7 give details of the numbers of women candidates and the number of women elected in the 1986 elections. Table L below shows that there has been a steady increase in women's participation in Regional elections since 1974. The proportion of candidates who are women has risen steadily to just under 20.0 percent while the proportion of women councillors has also increased. Labour continues to lag well behind the other main parties in fielding women candidates, but because of Labour dominance well over 50.0 percent of them were actually elected.

Minor Parties

Summary Table 12 gives details of the performances of minor parties and groups. The most striking new development in 1986 is the emergence of the Green Party which fielded 69 candidates and mustered more than 8,000 votes. As we noted above, however, this may prove to be merely a temporary phenomenon. Apart from the Greens, the list of "minor parties" contains the usual mixture of the disaffected, eccentric and "lost cause" standard bearers. One long-term development is, however, worthy of comment. This is the decline of the Communist Party. In 1974 there were 56 Communist Party Regional candidates, but this has fallen to 38 in 1978, 24 in 1982 and 13 in 1986. The Communist vote has similarly declined from 16,630 to 3,214. Throughout the period, however, the Communists have held on to a seat in Fife.

The Alliance Parties Compared

While the Liberals and the SDP fought the Regional elections as an Alliance all of their candidates except one could be identified as representing one or other of the parties. The respective performances of the two parties are shown in Table M.

As in 1982, the Liberals were somewhat more successful than their partners. This may reflect differential campaign effort but it seems likely that in large part it is a consequence of the nature of the "share-out" of seats rather than of any differential preference on the part of electors.

THE ELECTIONS FOR THE ORKNEY AND SHETLAND ISLANDS COUNCILS.

Note by W. J. A. Macartney

ORKNEY

Party labels first appeared in the Orkney Islands Council elections of 1982 when several Labour candidates (unsuccessfully) and one Orkney Movement candidate (successfully) contested the election. The experience of 1982 appears to have influenced the parties concerned. Thus in 1986 Labour put up only one official candidate (in Stromness, unsuccessfully) but five candidates declared themselves publicly as Orkney Movement candidates, three of them being successful. However the picture is obscured by the fact that two of them (the Councillors for Firth/Harray and Rousay, Egilsay & Wyre), despite their published statements of allegiance, neglected to describe themselves on the nomination form as Movement candidates and hence appeared on the official statistics as Independents. The founder-Chairman of the Orkney Movement retained his seat in the Kirkwall Weyland ward.

The genesis of the Orkney Movement goes back to the successful campaign against uranium mining in Orkney and the Movement has retained a strong conservationist flavour, enhanced by the protracted Dounreay inquiry taking place just across the Pentland Firth. Founded in 1980, after the Shetland Movement, the Orkney Movement clearly follows the Shetland Movement in its constitutional objectives, namely autonomy for Orkney and as an interim step, the expansion of the powers of the Orkney Islands Council. Both Movements have also declared their support for the establishment of a Scottish Constitutional Convention. The decentralisation strand is also found in the Orkney Movement, which campaigns for the retention and expansion of secondary schools in the outlying islands, and, as in Shetland, for systematic teaching of the islands' dialect.

SHETLAND

The focus of interest in the Shetland Islands Council elections was the debut of official Shetland Movement candidates on a sizeable scale (one-third of the seats). Although the Shetland Islands Council has always been dominated by Independents, party politics are no new thing in Shetland local government. Going back to the days before the Islands Councils, the Labour Party in Lerwick has put up local government candidates, often successfully, and in the 1986 elections Labour won four out of the five wards it contested. The Shetland Movement, which had at one time hoped to contest a majority of wards, put up eight official candidates, five of whom were successful, which on paper left Independents with a majority of the nine "party label" councillors. However the official returns disguise the fact that a number of Independents were in fact Shetland Movement members, many of them sitting councillors defending their seats, and the election as Council Convener of leading Shetland Movement member Edward Thomason tends to confirm this. Both Labour and the Shetland Movement claimed a moral victory - the former because their candidate in the Twageos ward knocked out one of the founding fathers of the Shetland Movement, Sandy Cluness; the latter because in their first official entry into the lists they won a majority of the seats they contested. It would be fair to say that the result was mildly satisfactory for all parties concerned but not a conclusive victory for anyone.

The Shetland Movement, whose origins go back to the 1977-80 period, stands for autonomy for Shetland and in the short term is campaigning for enhanced powers for the Council and especially the removal of central government restrictions on its spending powers. The local government manifesto issued was an expansionist one as well as stressing autonomist aims and a belief on decentralisation within the archipelago.
