Introduction

The latest - and what will almost certainly be the last - round of elections to the Scottish Regional Councils took place on May 5th 1994. Almost all of the Regional authorities are due to be abolished within the next couple of years. Despite this, a comprehensive review of the boundaries of Regional electoral divisions was undertaken and the changes came into operation at these elections. (Indeed, the Scottish Local Government Boundary Commission is currently busily reviewing the boundaries of District wards, many of which will also disappear, and the Parliamentary Boundary Commission has made recommendations for revised constituencies on the basis of the new electoral divisions.) The alterations to division boundaries are in many cases very extensive. A guide to these is given in Appendix 1 and this shows that only 96 out of 453 divisions were entirely or virtually unchanged. For that reason it is not sensible on this occasion to talk in terms of gains and losses by the parties in individual seats.

Since this is the last set of Regional elections - and despite the retirement of John Bochel - we have decided, in presenting the results, to retain the format that has been used throughout the Scottish Local Election results series since 1974. The Regions are listed in geographical rather than alphabetical order; the electoral divisions are listed by number and not alphabetically by name. *Aficianados* will be aware that divisions are numbered sequentially within Districts and in Appendix 2 we show which EDs are in which Districts.

The boundary changes also make the question of incumbency more problematic since it is misleading to describe a sitting councillor as being the incumbent of a redrawn division. We have identified retiring councillors with the following symbols (although these do not necessarily indicate incumbency in the division concerned).

- = retiring councillor elected in 1990
- * retiring councillor elected at a by-election since May 1990
- + retiring councillor who has changed parties since May 1990

Women candidates are identified by the prefix 'Ms' and the abbreviations used for the party affiliations of candidates (and the assorted other labels) are as follows:

We are grateful to John Bochel for help and advice, to June Rye of Lancaster University for invaluable assistance and to Adrian Coombes of Humberside University, who put considerable effort into producing a new computer package for tabulating and analysing the results. Michael Thrasher and Colin Rallings of the Local Government Elections Centre at the University of Plymouth have taken on the printing of the booklet in its final form. We are grateful for that and look forward to further cooperation in future.

Given the number of names and figures to be processed it is almost inevitable that errors will arise and we apologise in advance for any that remain despite our best efforts.

We believe that the (generally authoritative) printed collections of, and commentaries on Scottish local election results produced by John Bochel and David Denver since 1974 have proved useful to a variety of people - academics, people in the media, politicians and the political parties, and amateur enthusiasts. Although newspaper coverage of local election results has improved markedly over the years, especially, it should be said, in the Scottish quality press, there is still no central responsibility for collecting and publishing authoritative figures. We hope, therefore, to continue the series once the new structure of local government in Scotland is in place.

John Bochel's retirement means that both authors of this and future collections now work in English universities. The curious may like to know, however, that we are both Scots.

Commentary

From one perspective the 1994 Scottish Regional elections were meaningless. Over most of the country voters were being asked to elect councils which would shortly disappear under the government's proposed reorganisation of local government in Scotland. Normally the political parties fight for control of local authorities so that they can attempt to implement their distinctive policies in the areas concerned. The whole rationale of local democracy is that the electorate can hold a party or individuals responsible for their stewardship of local affairs and vote to throw the rascals out or confirm them in office. On the face of it, however, these considerations did not apply in 1994. There was little incentive for parties to seek control of a local authority that would shortly be consigned to history, and little point in electors seeking to reward or punish their local representatives.

From another perspective, however, the 1994 elections had as much importance as ever. They were widely signalled in advance as a major test of the popularity (or, perhaps more accurately, the level of *un*popularity) of the government. Local elections have always been treated as good indicators of the popularity of the parties, more reliable than opinion polls because they involve millions of electors and real votes rather than hypothetical voting intentions. But in 1994 the extreme unpopularity of the government over the country as a whole, the strains within the Conservative party and the parlous position of the Prime Minister combined to give the local elections even more significance than usual in this respect. It is over-simple to view the elections as a 'referendum' on John Major's leadership, as claimed by some media correspondents, but there is no doubt that voters use local elections as a vehicle for registering discontent with governments and it is certainly realistic to interpret local results as, to a large extent, a verdict on the performance of the government.

Politicians and others sometimes bemoan the fact that local elections do not generally hinge on the activities of local councils or the qualities of candidates and councillors. Even disregarding the imminent abolition of Regional authorities this is unrealistic. Small local authorities - the Scottish burghs, for example - in which a substantial proportion of the voters would know councillors personally were swept away in 1974 and replaced by large authorities such as the Regions. Inevitably these are more remote from the electorate; councillors have many more voters to represent and fewer voters have a chance of knowing a councillor. It is not surprising, therefore, that in most areas it is the party label of candidates that voters look to for guidance rather than their personal qualities or the record of the council.

In advance of the elections it was not difficult to guess what the verdict of the Scottish electorate would be. The government was very unpopular in the UK as a whole and appeared to be floundering over internal divisions on Europe, recently implemented increases in direct taxation, the imposition of VAT on domestic fuel and the hugely unpopular railway privatisation. In Scotland these problems were compounded by two other issues. Firstly, the government's proposals for restructuring local government appeared to have as its primary purpose the creation of authorities in which the Conservatives would have a chance of gaining control. Moreover, they were imposed by government fiat without any consideration by a commission, as was happening in England.

This was interpreted as typical Conservative insensitivity to Scottish opinion. Secondly, there was an outcry over the government's proposals for altering the management of the water industry. Their claim that these did not amount to privatisation were simply not believed and a few weeks before the local elections a referendum organised by Strathclyde Regional council produced a very high participation rate and a massive vote (97 per cent) against any attempt at privatisation. The referendum was simply dismissed by the Conservatives, although they held back from immediate privatisation. The government's handling of this issue appeared to betray either a profound lack of understanding of Scottish sensibilities or an insensitivity that is scarcely credible.

There was little doubt, then, that the mild recovery in Conservative fortunes seen in the 1992 general election, and the District elections which followed shortly after, would be reversed. What was less clear was how the other parties would perform. Labour had dominated Scottish local politics for two decades but had begun to look a little vulnerable in 1992 when, in the aftermath of their fourth consecutive general election defeat, they received their second-lowest ever share of the vote in the District elections. On the other hand, the SNP quickly recovered from the disappointment of not gaining seats in the general election and according to Scottish opinion polls were once again securely in second place in terms of popular support. The Liberal Democrats have never had the local election success in Scotland that they have enjoyed elsewhere. Their share of the vote in Regional elections peaked in 1982 but had declined sharply in 1986 and 1990. In 1994 they must have hoped to benefit from their improved national standing and from the unpopularity of the government.

In what follows we first analyse the results of the 1994 elections in detail and then, since this is the last in the present series, present a review of trends in Regional elections.

The Outcome

Candidates and Contests

A new record number of 1522 candidates contested the 1994 Regional elections. Details as compared with 1990 are shown in table A. Figures are shown separately for 'partisan' Regions (Grampian, Tayside, Fife, Lothian, Central, Strathclyde) which comprise about 91% of the Scottish electorate, and in which political parties dominate Regional elections, and for the 'non-partisan' Regions of Highland, Borders and Dumfries and Galloway, in which Independent candidates predominate.

In non-partisan areas all four major parties extended their electoral activity in 1994. Even so, these three Regions end their existence in the present structure as they began - still characterised by predominantly non-partisan local politics.

The number of women candidates (341) also reached a new high in 1994, but as a proportion of all candidates (22.4%) women made only a small advance on 1990 when the figure was 21.3%. Among the parties the Liberal Democrats had the largest proportion of women candidates (30%, as compared with 25% for the Conservatives, 20% for Labour and 18% for the SNP).

Given the record numbers of candidates it is not surprising to note that the proportion of divisions which were uncontested fell to a new low. There was a contest in every single seat in the partisan Regions and only 29 divisions in non-partisan Regions were taken without a contest - the bulk of them (20) going to Independents. Over Scotland as a whole, 94% of all divisions were contested in these elections.

Turnout

Overall turnout in the Regional elections, at 45.6% was very slightly down compared with 1990. There does not seem to be any clear Regional pattern to turnout change. There were increases in Highland and Dumfries and Galloway and relatively large decreases in Tayside and Lothian but otherwise turnout in 1994 was very close to the 1990 figure. Central had the highest Regional turnout (49.7%) and Grampian (as ever) the lowest (41.6%).

Patterns of Party Support

Table C shows the distribution of votes at the 1994 elections as compared with the last Regional elections in 1990.

As can be seen, the Conservative share of the vote fell to only 14.1% in partisan Regions, 8.3% in non-partisan and 13.7% in Scotland as a whole. This was their worst-ever performance in local elections. While Labour continued to be easily the largest party, its share of the vote in partisan areas declined slightly as compared with 1990. The major beneficiaries of the Conservative slump were the SNP, which was yet again clearly in second place, and the Liberal Democrats. In non-partisan Regions the long slow decline of Independents continued with a further fall to 41.3% of votes.

The Conservative share declined in every partisan Region (see table D) to the extent that they received only 9.8% of the vote in Fife and 10.7% in Strathclyde. These are staggeringly low figures for a major party. But Labour's failure to capitalise on government unpopularity is also clear. Only in Central, where the Liberal Democrats have historically been very weak, did Labour's vote share improve. While Labour remains dominant and still had more than half of all votes in Strathclyde, there appears to be a ceiling to Labour support in Scotland - just below the 45% mark - beyond which it is difficult to go. The advance of the SNP and Liberal Democrats was general and was particularly marked in Tayside and Grampian respectively, where these parties had a chance of at least sharing power.

Changes in party vote shares in local elections are significantly affected by changes in the number of candidates put forward by the parties. We can take account of this by considering changes in support in divisions where all four parties had candidates in both 1990 and 1994. Unfortunately the revisions of division boundaries in 1994 means that there are many fewer comparable divisions than normal. Nonetheless there were 40 divisions where boundaries were unaltered or were only slightly changed and where there was a four-party contest in both elections. The distribution of support in these divisions is

shown in table E. Given that these figures are based on a 'sample' of more than 200,000 voters, they are probably the most accurate indicators of the swing in Scottish opinion since the 1990 elections.

Measuring movements in electoral opinion since the 1992 general election is more problematical. If, however, we take as our 'sample' all 201 divisions in which there was a four-party contest (involving some 970,000 voters) and compare the distribution of votes in these with the general election result in partisan Regions, the changes are Conservative - 9.4%, Labour -0.5%, Liberal Democrats +6.1% and SNP +2.7%. Changes of this order would leave the Conservatives with only three of the current parliamentary constituencies - Eastwood, Edinburgh Pentlands and Dumfries.

Council Seats Won

In table F we show how these trends in party choice among voters were translated into Regional council seats, again distinguishing partisan and non-partisan Regions.

Despite losing 13 seats Labour's dominance of Regional councils remains impressive, with 60% of the seats in partisan Regions. Perhaps the most notable feature of the table, however, is the tale it tells of Conservative weakness. With just 31 seats in total the Conservatives were clearly in fourth place, winning just half of the number taken by the Liberal Democrats and fewer than half of the seats won by the SNP. The decline of the Conservatives in Regional elections has been startling. In 1978 they held 136 seats and in 1982 they had majority control of Grampian and Tayside. Just 12 years later in these two Regions they mustered only 8 seats out of 57 and 4 out of 46 respectively. In Grampian they have lost out mainly to the Liberal Democrats, who increased their seats total by 7 to

become the largest party, while in Tayside the SNP advanced by 12 seats, also becoming the largest party.

Women candidates won 78 seats (17.2%) - the biggest number and largest proportion to date.

Minor Parties and Others (See Summary Table 12)

At the 1990 round of Regional elections the Green Party made something of an impact, fielding 109 candidates, garnering just over 35,000 votes (the highest-ever total for a minor party in Regional elections) and winning their first-ever seat on a Scottish local authority, in Highland. In 1994, however, the Greens withered somewhat, putting forward only 36 candidates and gaining just over 6,000 votes. In terms of votes the most successful minor party was Scottish Militant Labour with just over 11,000 votes, but only two 'Others' won a seat in contested divisions - an Independent Labour candidate in Tayside and a Communist in Fife. This seat in Fife has been held continuously by the Communist party since 1974. The Natural Law Party's first appearance in Regional elections did not give rise to any great excitement. One of their candidates achieved the distinction of gaining the fewest votes of anyone in the election (7).

Trends in Regional Elections

As noted above, the 1994 Regional elections were the last to be held under the current local government system. It is appropriate, therefore, to review briefly some of the major trends in Regional elections over the twenty years since 1974.

Candidates and Contests

Table G shows the number of candidates put forward by each of the parties at each election. Three points stand out from these figures. The first is the growth in the total number of candidates. After a dip in 1978 the number grew steadily and in 1994 was 374 greater than in 1974 - an increase of 33%. If the health of local democracy is indicated by the willingness of people to stand for election then the system of Regional councils would appear to have been successful.

Note: Here and in subsequent tables 'Lib Dem' is used to refer to the series of party names used by what might loosely be called 'the centre' - Liberal, SLD etc.

The second point to note in the figures is the decline of Independent candidates. This has been an important feature of local elections since 1974 and it illustrated further in subsequent tables. It is clearly linked to the third noteworthy point in the table - the growth in the number of party candidates. All the main parties increased their number of candidates but the growth in the numbers of 'centre' and SNP candidates is truly spectacular. This latter reflects the increasing complexity of the Scottish (and British) party system, but the overall increase in party activity is largely a result of the change in the local government structure made in 1974. Many small towns and rural areas, with a non-partisan tradition of local politics were either combined into much larger Districts (and, in turn, very large Regions) or merged with urban areas which had a well-established partisan tradition. Moreover, the fresh start implied by the new system enabled the Conservatives to become more active in local politics than before, since they could now intervene in places where previously localised anti-Labour associations had contested local elections.

An unmistakable trend in Regional elections has been towards greater participation on the part of women as candidates and councillors. As table H shows, women constituted only 12.1% of candidates in 1974 but this increased in every subsequent election and by 1994 had reached 22.4%. Similarly, there has been a steady increase in women councillors from 10.2% in 1974 to 17.4% in 1994.

It might be anticipated that a consequence of increased party activity in Scottish local politics over the past twenty years would be an increase in the number of seats contested. Parties have incentives to contest elections, even when there is little prospect of victory, that Independents and others do not have - the need to exercise their electoral machines, to provide a candidate for their supporters and so on. Table I provides the relevant figures.

Under the old local government system only around half of seats were contested but it can be seen that since 1974 the figure has been much higher. There was a great flurry of activity at the first elections for the new authorities (both Regional and District elections were held on the same day). Thereafter there was something of a settling down but in the last two rounds of elections there were record high proportions of contested sets.

Turnout

The relatively low turnout in local elections is frequently bemoaned. In fact given the relative (and growing) impotence of local authorities it is perhaps the fact that so many people do take the trouble to vote that demands explanation! The overall turnout figures for Regional elections since 1974 are shown in table J. Again, there is evidence of a flurry of interest - this time on the part of the electors - in the first set of elections. Thereafter, with the exception of 1982 when there was a clear dip in participation levels, turnout over Scotland as a whole was always around the 45% mark, although there was more variation in non-partisan areas.

Although there are no reliable figures for turnout in Scottish local elections before the present structure was implemented it is certain that they would never have witnessed turnouts of this level over the country as a whole. In terms of improving the participation of voters the regional councils must be adjudged a success.

Patterns of Party Competition

The increase in party candidates in Regional elections has produced important changes in the nature of the choices faced by electors. The first change has been a steady growth in the proportion of electoral divisions which were contested by at least two of the major parties. This is seen in table K. In partisan Regions the figure has always been high but in the later elections almost every division witnessed a party contest. In non-partisan areas the 1990s have seen a rapid rise in the proportion of party contests of some form.

Note: A major party contest is defined as any contested election in which candidates of at least two of the four major parties were involved.

The evolving nature of party competition at Regional level is charted in table L and the rise in the proportion of party contests which involved all four major parties is striking. These sorts of contests - which parallel the kind of choices faced by electors in general elections - were rare in 1974 but by the end of the period they accounted for well over half of contests. Three-way contests have remained at about the same level but two-way contests have declined spectacularly (from 61% in 1974 to 6% in 1990). In particular, straight fights between the Conservatives and Labour, which were the most common form of contest in 1974, have all but disappeared. Overall, the data in this table are testimony to the increasing complexity of the party system in Scotland.

Trends in party support

Candidatures, contests, turnout and party competition may be of interest to academics interested in local elections but to most commentators all that matters is how the parties have performed. Local election results are widely interpreted as indicating the state of the parties' popularity between general elections. Table M shows the distribution of votes among the parties at Regional elections since 1974.

These are 'raw' figures, in the sense that they take no account of variations in candidatures and contests, but they give a rough guide to the popularity of the various

parties in Scotland over the period. The decline of Independents referred to earlier is again evident. Since 1978 their support has hovered around the 5% level. Labour has been the largest party in terms of popular support at every election, peaking at 43.9% of votes cast in 1986. It may be some comfort to their opponents, however, that Labour support has declined slightly in the last two elections. Nonetheless, it is worth commenting that despite the impression of intense party competition conveyed by table L, Labour is clearly the dominant party in Scotland. The SNP have a fair claim to be the second party since they have outpolled the Conservatives in the last three elections while Liberal Democrat support is rather variable.

Most of these comments are amplified when applied to data showing the number of seats won by the parties. Details are given in table N. Again, the decline of Independents and the dominance of Labour is clear. The steady progress of the Liberal Democrats is worth noting, however - they seem to be more successful at winning and retaining seats than they are at gaining votes.

Conclusion

One clear message of this consideration of trends in local election results in Scotland from 1974 is that the structure introduced then helped to hasten the demise of non-partisan local politics. The number of Independent candidates, the share of votes that they won and the number of council seats that they gained have all declined over the period and are certainly very much smaller than was the case under the old system. The message as far as party competition is concerned is more ambiguous. While it is true that more individual electoral divisions are now contested by the major parties, the fact is that Labour has dominated Scottish local government and politics. They have far outstripped their opponents in terms of votes won and seats gained at every election. If we look at party control of the Regions, the impression that there has been a trend towards competitive four-party politics seems over-simple. Between 1974 and 1994 no Region has been controlled with an overall majority by two different parties. Labour has had a majority in Strathclyde and Fife throughout the period, in Central at every election except the first (when they were the largest party) and in Lothian at four of the six elections (the other two producing no overall majority). Grampian and Tayside have been more competitive. The former had a Conservative majority in 1974, 1978 and 1982 but no party in overall control since (Labour was largest in 1986 and 1990 and the Liberal Democrats in 1994). The latter also had Conservative majorities in 1978 and 1982 and no overall control thereafter (Labour being the largest party in 1986 and 1990 and the SNP in 1994).

Nonetheless, almost three-quarters of the Scottish population live in Regions that have been either always or almost always controlled by Labour. It is perhaps more accurate to view Regional councils in the central belt of Scotland as comprising a four large Labour fiefdoms rather than as a series of miniature versions of central government. It may be precisely this perception that lies behind the latest moves to alter the structure of local government yet again. But given Labour's hold on the electorate it is doubtful whether *any* structure of Scottish local government will make very much difference. No matter how the boundaries are drawn the vast majority of the population will continue to be governed by Labour at local level.

Appendix 1: Changes to the Boundaries of Regional Electoral Divisions

Between the 1990 and 1994 rounds of Regional elections the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland carried out a statutory comprehensive review of the boundaries of electoral divisions. The changes made came into effect in 1994. The following gives an indication of the extent of identity between the former and the new divisions. For each new division we have calculated an index of identity which is defined as 100 - (number of electors moved from relevant old division + number of electors moved to new division, as a percentage of the electorate of the old division). Thus a score of 100 indicates no change. Scores greater than 99.5 are shown as '99*'. Where the index score is less than 70 the division is simply described as 'new'. In many cases the numbering of divisions has been altered and, where appropriate, the number in brackets is the number of the old division with which the new should be compared.
