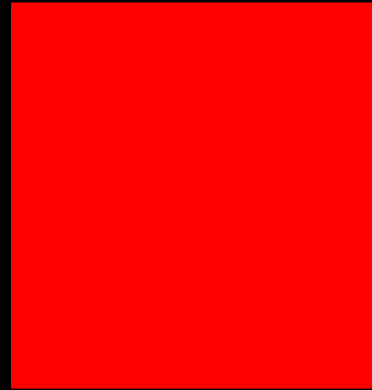

INTRODUCTION

For the first time for some years, the local government elections of 1989 resulted in a reduction in the number of councils where no one party won an overall majority. The shire county contests in England and Wales saw both Labour and the Conservatives improve upon their 1985 performance, squeezing the former Alliance vote. The uneasy divorce of the Liberals and the SDP, and the subsequent merger of the major part of each party as the Social and Liberal Democrats, contributed to a decline in electoral support for the centre. The consequence of this was a decline from 21 to 12 in the number of counties where neither Labour nor the Conservatives could on their own form an administration.

Table 1 presents some basic information on how each party fared. The Conservatives fielded the most candidates, won the most seats and gained the largest share of the vote in England. Labour claimed each of these distinctions in Wales. There were almost three candidates for every seat in England, but only just over two in Wales - a reflection of the still large number of unopposed returns in the principality (see Table 2). The Democrats managed to put forward over 2300 candidates, and their share of the vote in seats contested suggests that they were successful in targeting their most promising divisions. The SDP did only half as well as their erstwhile partners in both England and Wales, and were overshadowed - at least in terms of candidature - by the Green Party. The Greens won an average of 9.3% of the vote in those divisions they contested and had two councillors elected. A good result, but in no way foreshadowing their success at the European elections just five weeks later.

The average turnout in contested seats in Wales was some 5% better than that in England, but England can claim a far higher proportion of women candidates and councillors (Table 2).

A comparison of the shares of the vote gained by the various parties at the 1985 and 1989 county council elections puts some statistical flesh on our discussion. As Table 3 shows, in England there was a modest increase in support for both the Conservative and Labour parties. The Democrats polled 8% less than had the Alliance partners in 1985, and there was a 3% increase in the votes gained by other parties -largely as a result of the Greens contesting more seats.

For the two major parties, however, the sharpest contrast is between their county and general election performances. Once again this year Labour's relative success in non-metropolitan England was acclaimed in party circles as marking a turning point in their fortunes. Opinion polls were soon to follow this electoral cue and Labour has enjoyed a consistent lead since the early summer. What the party must now strive to understand is why voters in certain electorally crucial areas are only prepared to support Labour at local elections. For some years now Labour has comfortably 'won' places like Harlow, Ipswich, Slough and Stevenage at the local level, only to see those constituencies slip away at a general election. The Conservatives can of course draw comfort from this analysis in reverse. All past evidence suggests that when electors' minds are concentrated on the task of choosing the next government, fully half the electors in the English shires support the Tories.

In Wales, the variation in party fortunes is at least partly explained by different patterns of contestation. Nevertheless, in comparison with 1985, Labour fell back a little while the Tories picked up some support. Once again, however, it was the Democrats who fared least well, falling back to fourth place behind Plaid Cymru despite fielding more candidates than the nationalists.

Yet, these aggregate figures conceal some quite considerable variations in performance. The prominence of local issues and the work done by well known individual candidates can often lead to results against the trend. Even at the level of the county, however, it cannot be assumed that uniform swing will be the order of the day. Table 4 sets out the share of the vote by party in each county, together with a comparison with their 1985 performance. These figures clearly make the point that we are not dealing simply with a nationally determined set of elections. For example, although the Conservatives seem to have recorded their biggest increase in shares of the vote in those counties where Democrat support was in sharpest decline, one has to look at the politics of individual local authorities to explain exactly why this is so.

In Devon, there can be little doubt that the result was influenced by the not entirely harmonious way in which a varying group of Democrat, SDP and Labour councillors had run the county for the previous four years. Conversely, in Gloucestershire, the minority Alliance (and then Democrat) administration had a sufficiently positive public perception to protect its members from the national movement against their party. On the Labour side, to take just one example, the improvement in vote share in Nottinghamshire can be directly explained by a decrease in the political controversy over the Union of Democratic Miners. In Kent, the much below average increase in Tory support is very likely a reflection of public disquiet over the Channel Tunnel. On the other hand, the large increase in the Conservative share of the vote in Cornwall owed little to politics, but much to the party fielding many more candidates than in 1985.

Nevertheless, the ability and willingness of the voting population to make locally relevant decisions arguably protected the Democrats from a more damaging result. Although they lost a quarter of the former Alliance seats in England and a third of those in Wales, if the swing had been uniform across the country they would only have held 330 divisions in England and fewer than 20 in Wales. The concentration of Democrat candidates and the wide fluctuations in their level of support is particularly highlighted in the statistics for each District contained within the body of the Handbook.

The figures on party fortunes within Wales are heavily influenced by changing patterns of contestation, and by the fact that six of the eight Welsh counties underwent wholesale boundary revisions between 1985 and 1989. Politics, however, does explain the result in South Glamorgan, where both turnout and party support reflects the result of the Vale of Glamorgan parliamentary byelection held on the same day within the County.

The overall picture of local variations within a national trend is one on which we have had cause to comment before. The parties and the media have drawn general lessons from these elections, but the closer to the electorate one gets the more scope there is for idiosyncratic results. It is at the level of ward or division that the diversity of local politics is truly preserved, and that can only be good for the health of democracy.

Notes:

- 1) Boundary changes took place between 1985 and 1989 in all the Welsh counties except Clwyd (process not completed in time) and South Glamorgan (changes completed before 1985). In England, divisions in the Gedling district of Nottinghamshire underwent boundary changes between 1985 and 1989. In none of these cases has a result for the 1985 election been listed.
- 2) In three divisions the election was postponed due to the death of a candidate during the campaign period. In each case the result is listed with a note of when the contest was actually held. The three instances were in: Tavistock, Devon; Hawarden No.3, Clwyd; and Eastwood and Brinsley, Nottinghamshire.
- 3) The result of the election on 4th May in Goring, Oxfordshire, originally decided by the toss of a coin after a tie, was subsequently declared void by the High Court. A fresh election was held on 21st September with the following result:

The turnout, doubtless prompted by the contest's notoriety, was 61.0%.

Each County (named at the top) has one page devoted to a summary of its electoral statistics.

The composition of the Council refers to the make-up of the full Council immediately after the completion of the electoral cycle.

The number of seats contested by each party is listed. '% share' is the proportion of the total valid vote in the County polled by each party. '% change 85/89' shows how this figure has changed since 1985. For the purposes of calculation, the SLD have been deemed the inheritors of the entire 1985 Alliance vote. The average turnout for each county can be found in Table 21 at the back.

Each District within the County is listed alphabetically, and three summary statistics included. The average turnout within the District is in brackets beneath the District Name. '% share' is defined as above except that it is calculated for the District alone. 'Seats won' indicates the number of county council seats within that District won by each party.

Exact details of the 1985 County Council results for England are available in Colin Rallings and Michael Thrasher, *The 1985 County Council Election Results in England* (Plymouth : Centre for the Study of Local Elections, 1985).

The results for each division are listed in alphabetical order within Districts, across the page. The start of each district is clearly marked in the text.

The figure in brackets is the electorate for 1989. The practice adopted by Counties for calculating this figure varies - in some cases it includes all names on the 1989 electoral register; in others it is a more accurate record of only those entitled to vote on election day in May. It has been impossible to adopt a standard definition of electorate or to identify the particular procedures adopted by Counties.

Candidates are listed in descending order of vote. The first initial is included. Ms after a candidate's name indicates a woman, and * indicates the candidate was a member of the previous council.

The abbreviations used for party are relatively straightforward:

In the case of the Social and Liberal Democrats, we have kept a more accurate record of the labels actually used by candidates. The following labels are used in the division results, and it is from them that the district and county aggregate figures for the SLD are calculated.

Vote is the number of electors who supported each candidate and Share the proportion of the total number who cast a valid ballot supporting each candidate.

Turnout is proportion of the electorate who voted. Like the figure for electorate size, this statistic suffers slightly from a lack of consistency in the way in which Counties present their results. Some include rejected ballot papers in their returns; others do not; and in some cases practice varies from District to District within a County. Our figure for turnout is, in every case, the proportion of the electorate given for the division who cast valid ballots.

Majority is an expression of the lead of the winning candidate over that of the second placed candidate in percentage terms rounded to one decimal point. This is displayed at the bottom of the 'share' column.

The result in 1985 is listed against '1985: '. Where no result is given, significant boundary changes have taken place between 1985 and 1989. The result for 1989 can be determined by inspection.
